SUBJECT: Wing Environmental Policy Statement (S/S 377ABW/CC Memorandum, February 2010, Environmental Policy Statement)

1. The 377th Air Base Wing (ABW) is committed to conducting its mission in an environmentally responsible manner to protect human health, natural resources, and the environment. The 377 ABW will comply with all environmental laws and regulations applicable to the mission of providing nuclear surety, expeditionary forces, and support to base operations. In the future, as in the past, we will continue to pursue a course of continual process improvement to enhance our environmental performance. In support of our environmental policy, we will:

- a. Appoint organizational Unit Environmental Coordinators (UECs) to address environmental matters.
 - b. Set environmental goals to sustain the mission, measure progress, maintain compliance, and protect our natural resource assets. Implement actions to meet these goals and communicate results to applicable personnel, suppliers, contractors, and/or regulators.
 - c. Maintain an effective pollution prevention program, by recycling materials, minimizing waste, disposing of hazardous wastes in an environmentally responsible manner, and restore contaminated sites.
 - d. Ensure the responsible use of energy throughout the installation through the adoption of practices and procedures to conserve energy, improve energy efficiency, and promote sustainability.
 - e. Provide routine, operation-specific, environmental performance reviews and assessments that will identify non-compliance situations, and institute documented corrective and preventative action plans.
2. Conformity to this policy is the responsibility of every member of the 377 ABW according to his/her role and responsibility to support mission capability.
