Message from the Command Team

The 377th Air Base Wing is the host organization at Kirtland Air Force Base. The Wing is a combat decorated unit with over five decades of service that spans from the jungles of Vietnam, to the front lines of the Cold War in Germany, to nuclear enterprise operations in the high desert of New Mexico and the coast of California.

The primary mission of the 377 ABW "Fighting Tigers" is to provide logistics, maintenance support, test operations and security for nuclear operations to ensure the long-term capability of the nuclear force. The 377 ABW hosts 108 mission partners from five MAJCOMs, nine wings, four military branches, Department of Defense agencies and the Department of Energy, employing more than 24,000 national security professionals. The wing includes America's only dedicated Intercontinental Ballistic Missile (ICBM) test unit, responsible for



excuting tests that accuratly measure the current and future capability of the ICBM force. The 377 ABW delivers critical installation support to the myriad mission.

Our top priority is Advanced Nuclear Capabilities. The consequences for failure in nuclear operations are much higher than other areas, so resources will be allocated first and foremost to this priority. We will continue to provide excellent support to our Airmen and Guardians and their families, while striving to improve services for them every single day. Finally, we will build upon our relationships with our mission partners, community partners, and neighbors and continue to build new ones as we answer our nation's call together.
