Blazon. On a disc Azure, below a stylized eagle displayed Sable, wings inverted, eyed and fimbriated Or, tongued and armed Gules, a butcher knife, point downward Proper, and a key, ward downwards of the third, in saltire; all within a narrow Yellow border.

Attached below the disc a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "377TH FORCE SUPPORT SQ" in Yellow letters.

Significance. Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The eagle is derived from the Federal Republic of Germany's coat of arms and emphasizes that the Squadron served in Germany. The knife represents the food service and the key symbolizes the billeting and customer service mission of the unit.
