Lineage. Constituted as 377 Transportation Squadron, activated, and organized on 8 Apr 1966. Inactivated on 28 Mar 1973. Activated on 1 Jan 1993. Redesignated as 377 Logistics Readiness Squadron on 1 Oct 2002.

Assignments. 377 Combat Support Group (later, 377 Air Base Wing), 8 Apr 1966-28 Mar 1973. 377 Logistics Group, 1 Jan 1993; 377 Mission Support Group, 1 Oct 2002-.

Stations. Tan Son Nhut Afld, South Vietnam, 8 Apr 1966-28 Mar 1973. Kirtland AFB, NM, 1 Jan 1993-.

Blazon. On a disc Sable, a tiger Proper crouching over a terrestrial globe Azure edged and fimbriated Argent, land masses Vert edge and fimbriated of the third, in base of globe nineteen small discs arced to dexter, six and six small discs arced to sinister; tiger sinister paw, four talons scraping across the globe marks of Or edged Argent; all within a narrow border Yellow.

Attached above the disc, a Black scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "SUSTINENDUM VICTORIAM" in Yellow letters.

Attached below the disc, a Black scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "377TH LOGISTICS READINESS SQ" in Yellow letters.

Significance. Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The tiger crouching over the globe symbolizes the Squadron's pride in its parent command and in its worldwide mission to defend the United States. The four claw marks represent the Squadron's four flights: Deployment and Distribution, Vehicle Management, Fuels, and Supply. The small white discs at the base of the globe signify 1966, the year the unit was constituted and the time to which the Squadron dates its history and heritage from its earliest beginnings in Vietnam. The Latin motto, "SUSTINENDUM VICTORIAM," translates to "SUSTAINING VICTORY" in English.
