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<p>TAP Workshop 1-3 August 2022, 0800-1600 (Room 120)</p>	<p>Step 3 of the Transition Assistance Program (TAP) is the 3-day TAP Workshop and one or more of the 2-day Transition Tracks. The TAP Workshop helps transitioning Service members prepare for civilian life and meet the mandatory Career Readiness Standards. Monday is the mandatory DoD Training Day. Tuesday is the mandatory VA Benefits and Services briefing. Wednesday is the DOL Employment Fundamentals of Career Transition, which is mandatory unless exempt. Initial Counseling and Preseparation Counseling must be completed before attending the TAP Workshop. Spouses are welcome and encouraged to attend. Dress code is casual civilian business attire. Participants should bring their personal laptop to use for workshop activities.</p>

<p>Retiree Group Briefing 9 August 2022, 0800-1200 (Room 120) 23 August 2022, 0800-1200 (A&FRF Training Room) Separatee Group Briefing 11 & 25 August 2022, 0800-1130 (Room 120)</p>	<p>Step 1 of the Transition Assistance Program (TAP) is Initial Counseling and Step 2 is Preseparation Counseling. Both Initial Counseling and Preseparation Counseling must be accomplished NOT LESS THAN 365 days before separation or retirement. TAP is mandatory for all separating/retiring Service members on Title 10 orders for 180 or more consecutive days. Service members should start TAP 14-18 months before separation or 14-24 months before retirement. Spouses are welcome and encouraged to attend. The Self-Assessment and Individual Transition Plan (ITP) must be completed and returned to the A&FRF before attending Initial Counseling. Preseparation Counseling ensures Service members are informed of the services and benefits available to assist them and their families with the transition to civilian life. Spouses are welcome and encouraged to attend.</p>

Capstone is complete when the transitioning Service member's commander certifies that the Service member is prepared to transition to civilian life by reviewing and signing the Service member's eForm.</p>
