<p><u>BX Pharmacy Prescription Procedures</u></p> <p>To activate a new prescription that your provider sent to the Kirtland Bx Pharmacy, you will need to utilize the GENESIS Patient Portal to MESSAGE the pharmacy. The direct link to the patient portal is: https://patientportal.mhsgenesis.health.mil. If you do not have internet access, you may activate in-person through the BX Pharmacy Kiosk (for same day pickup) or the BX Pharmacy Drop Box (for pickup in 48 hours). Over-the-phone activations are not accepted.</p> <p>Refills may be requested by sending a MESSAGE through the GENESIS Patient Portal or by calling the automated refill line at 505-846-5770.</p> <p><u>Step-by-step instructions on how to message the Kirtland Pharmacy</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To access the GENESIS Patient Portal, you must have a DS LOGON account. 2. To create an account, go to https://www.dmdc.osd.mil/identitymanagement/app/login. Choose "Create New Account". Then, select "I have my DoD ID Card or CAC, but NO access to a CAC reader and "Continue". An email with an activation code will be sent to the email address on file with instructions. NOTE: each eligible family member must create their own DS LOGON account, using their own UNIQUE email address. 3. To activate a new prescription, log into the GENESIS Patient Portal, select "Messaging" or "Send a Message": 4. In the "TO" box, type "Kirtland Pharmacy". The subject and body of your email should indicate what you are requesting. <p><u>I've never used the BX Pharmacy – What do I do?</u></p> <p>In order to use the BX Pharmacy, you need to be registered in GENESIS (the medical records system currently being used by the military). To get added to the system, call Kirtland AFB Health Benefits Outpatient Records, (505) 846-3417. Once they have added you to the GENESIS system, you can start ordering your prescriptions through the BX Pharmacy by creating a DS LOGON account and following the instructions above.</p>	<p>BX Pharmacy Prescription Procedures</p>
<p><u>Is My Prescription Covered By TriCare?</u></p> <p>The TRICARE Formulary Search Tool is available at https://www.express-scripts.com/frontend/open-enrollment/tricare/fst/#/. It shows if your drug is covered, where you can fill it, and if your provider needs to request pre-authorization.</p>	<p>TriCare Prescription Formulary</p>
<p><u>ID Card Appointments</u></p> <p>The Military Personnel Flight (MPF) has asked for our assistance. As a community, we are tying up their phones lines to request ID card appointments. The office is presently understaffed and they have added supporting us with DS LOGON identity verification. In order to help them out, we are asking that those of us who can access a computer, sign up for ID card appointments online at: https://idco.dmdc.osd.mil/idco/.</p> <p>If you have an issue with the site, you can request an appointment through their org box. For detailed instructions, see: https://kirtlandforcesupport.com/military-personnel/. This box is monitored daily.</p> <p>For your convenience, Military Family Readiness has public computers available for your use at the Consolidated Support Facility, Building 20245, Room 126.</p> <p>If you do not have access to a computer, please call or visit our office Tuesday – Friday, 1200 – 1500 and one of our staff will be happy to set up an ID Card appointment with you.</p>	<p>ID Cards</p>

<p><u>Federal Income Tax Withholding</u> Please be aware that when the Federal government recalculated tax withholding rates for this year, it may have resulted in a decreased amount of tax being withheld from Retiree and annuitant pay. This could result in insufficient tax being withheld throughout the 2023 tax year. Retirees and annuitants are encouraged to review their tax withholding to ensure it meets their needs and individual tax circumstances. To change your federal tax withholding, mail IRS Form W-4P to Defense Finance and Accounting Service, Military Annuitant Pay, 8899 E. 56th ST, Indianapolis, IN 46249-1300 or fax it to DFAS at 800-982-8459 or log into your myPay account at https://mypay.dfas.me.</p>	<p>Federal Income Tax Withholding</p>
<p><u>SBP Open Season</u> There is currently an open season for the Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP), 23 December 2022 – 1 January 2024. The SBP Open Season allows eligible retirees, reserve and guard retirees, and Gray Area retirees who on 22 December 2022 were not participating in SBP or Reserve Component SBP (RCSBP) to enroll in the plan or discontinue participation in the plan. The process starts with a Letter of Intent (LOI) to enroll. Complete details are available at https://www.dfas.mil/sbpopenseason23.
