Installation Commander's Directive update – ICD #038B: Effective Friday, September 25, 2020

HEALTH MEASURES

- 1. Due to the ongoing COVID-19 conditions on our installation and in the surrounding area, the installation commander has renewed the Declaration of a Public Health Emergency, dated March 13, 2020. This declaration renewal will terminate on **November 30, 2020**.
- 2. COVID-19 testing at the 377 MDG has transitioned to **appointment only** (effective Sept. 21, 2020). If you are experiencing possible symptoms of COVID-19, including a cough, shortness of breath, muscle or body aches, fatigue, headache, chills, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, and new loss of taste or smell, please call the appointment line at 505-846-3200 for an appointment at the COVID tent, located between the dental clinic and the main 377 MDG building. All others seeking COVID-19 testing (i.e. for asymptomatic close contacts, deployment screening/testing, employment/healthcare related, etc.) should call public health at 505-846-3461 to determine when/if testing is required and to be scheduled to do so if indicated.
- 3. Individuals **CANNOT** test out of ROM with a Negative COVID-19 test. They must meet all criteria prior to release of ROM.

ACCESS

- 1. East Side Fitness Center remains reserved for Active Duty Military from opening until 11 a.m. daily. All other patrons may use the gym after 11a.m. only. West side fitness center remains closed at this time.
- 2. Ride Share Programs (i.e. Uber, Lyft, etc.) are **reinstated**, and may use any available gate.
 - A. Passengers must comply with all ride share specific COVID-19 requirements.
 - B. Face coverings are **mandatory** for all passengers.

ACTIVITIES

Coordinate all on-base events and activities (Commanders Calls, Promotion Ceremonies, base picnics, morale events, potlucks etc.) through the 377th MDG Public Health office. Public Health will provide recommendations based on the most up-to-date CDC and New Mexico Department of Health guidelines to help mitigate as much COVID-19 risk as possible.
