Military and Civilian members have a duty to promptly report violations (fraud, waste and abuse, gross mismanagement, a violation of law, policy, procedures, an injustice, abuse of authority, inappropriate conduct or misconduct) to a supervisor, commander, an IG, or through established grievance channels. Complaints may be filed in person, by letter, via email or through a complaint hotline.

AF Form 102 is the preferred method to submit your issue to the IG. The form allows the client to: disclose their identity; remain confidential with the IG; or, remain anonymous. If you file a complaint anonymously, we will not know who you are, and we will not be able to contact you to request additional information or inform you of the resolution.

You have the right to submit a complaint at any level you desire, from the Wing IG up to and including the Department of Defense IG. However, complaints are best resolved using the chain of command or the Wing IG because your commander and the Wing IG have a vested interest in resolving problems which impact morale and mission effectiveness as well as easier access to records and witnesses.

If you think adverse action has been taken against you, or you have been denied a favorable action, because you reported a violation (fraud, waste and abuse, gross mismanagement, a violation of law, policy, procedures, an injustice, abuse of authority, inappropriate conduct or mis-conduct) to your chain of command, an IG, or through established grievance channels, report it to the IG office immediately.

Title 10 U.S.C. 1034 prohibits anyone from restricting a member of the Armed Forces from making a lawful communications to a member of Congress or an Inspector General.
