

# AIR & SPACE FORCE VICTIMS' COUNSEL (VC) EXPANSION OF LEGAL SERVICES TO VICTIMS OF INTERPERSONAL VIOLENCE



- **Interpersonal violence (IPV)** includes: dating, family, and workplace violence
- What VCs can do for **IPV victims**:
  - Provide **confidential** legal advice
  - Explain the military justice and administrative processes
  - Provide information on your legal rights as a crime victim
  - Process referrals to other victim support services
- Eligibility is limited – contact your local VC office for further information
- Walk-in hours: Wednesdays, 1000-1500, or by appointment.
- **Contact your VC, SARC, FAP, VWAP Coordinator or Base Legal Office to request a VC.**
  - Restricted Reports: Go to the VC, SARC, Victim Advocate, Chaplain, or health care provider to ensure the report remains restricted.
