Plan My Move 1 May 2024, 0800-1100 Room 120	First time moving? Not your first PCS move? Separating? Have questions about your upcoming government move? Representatives from the following agencies will provide information and answer questions: Military & Family Readiness Flight, Installation Voting Assistance Office, Military One Source, TMO-Household Goods, Finance-Travel Entitlements, Personal Financial Readiness, Military Housing Office, Kirtland Family Housing, TRICARE, Military & Family Life Counselors (MFLC), School Liaison Officer & Exceptional Family Member Program.				
First Duty Station - Officer 1 May 2024, 1300-1500 M&FRC Training Room	Participants will learn about personal financial budgets, debt reduction, Thrift Savings Plan, the Air Force Aid Society, and other financial topics to assist themselves and those they supervise. All first duty station officers are required to attend this brief within 90 days of being arriving at KAFB.

Spouses are welcome and encouraged to attend. The Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) Mass Briefing is mandatory for all retiring Service members. SBP provides the survivors of participating retirees a monthly income that starts when the member dies and retired pay stops. Spouses are welcome and strongly encouraged to attend.

Capstone is complete after the Service member's commander has reviewed and signed the Service member's eForm				
TAP Workshop 6-8 May 2024, 0800-1600 Room 120	Step 3 of the Transition Assistance Program (TAP) is the 3-day TAP Workshop and the 2-day Transition Tracks. The TAP Workshop helps transitioning Service members prepare for civilian life and meet the mandatory Career Readiness Standards. Dress code is casual civilian business attire. Participants should bring their personal laptop to use for workshop activities. Wi-Fi is available in the classroom. Initial Counseling and Preseparation Counseling must be completed before attending the TAP Workshop.
