Confidential 24/7 assistance for reporting a sexual assault or retaliation

**Sexual Assault Reporting Options:** Individuals may disclose a sexual assault incident to anyone in or outside of their chain of command. A report made outside of the chain of command can remain confidential when made to: SARC, SAPR VA, VVA, healthcare personnel, assigned Victim's Counsel, chaplain or through the DoD Safe Helpline.

Restricted	Unrestricted
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>* Available to military/dependents (18 yrs+)</li><li>* Confidential</li><li>* No commander notification</li><li>* Does not trigger an investigation</li><li>* May <i>not</i> file <b>if</b> victim has personally reported the sexual assault to SFS, OSI or previously filed an unrestricted report for the same incident</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>* Available to military/dependents, DoD civilians/dependents (18 yrs+), and Contractors – <b><u>ONLY when they are OCONUS</u></b></li><li>* Commander notification</li><li>* Triggers an investigation</li><li>* May request: military/civilian protective order and expedited transfer</li><li>* May not convert to a restricted report</li></ul>
<b>Regardless of reporting option, victims are eligible for:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Mental Health, Chaplain, and SAPR advocacy services</li><li>Medical treatment</li><li>Sexual Assault Forensic Exam (SAFE)</li><li>Victim's Counsel representation</li><li>Participation in the CATCH Program</li></ul>	

**CATCH Program:** Victims voluntarily submit an anonymous entry into the CATCH database to discover if the suspect in their report may have also assaulted another person. With knowledge of a "potential match", victims can then decide whether to participate in an investigation of a serial offender suspect.

**Military Sexual Trauma (MST):** The VA (Veterans Affairs) provides free treatment for any physical or mental health conditions related to an experience of MST. You do not need documentation of the MST experience or a VA disability rating to receive care.

**Retaliation:** Individuals who believe they have been retaliated against, related to a reported sexual assault, may report retaliation allegations to: SARC/SAPR VA; SVC; DoD Safe Helpline; OSI; Commander, or a commander outside or higher up their chain of command; IG (reprisal only). The following individuals can experience retaliation: adult sexual assault victims with an unrestricted report; adult sexual assault victim's adult family member (e.g., spouse, son, daughter); witnesses, bystanders associated with the report; SARC/SAPR VA; and responders.
