



Eubank Gate Security Improvement Project

Construction starts October 1



Construction is set to begin on a 12-month road construction project on Kirtland Air Force Base (KAFB), west of the Eubank gate entrance. The Air Force is making security improvements and a new road will provide access to the NNSA Albuquerque Complex.

The Eubank gate will remain open. However, those who live, work, and provide services to the base could experience impacts at certain times due to lane closures.

To minimize traffic congestion during construction, KAFB and Sandia are:

- Keeping the gate operational during construction.
- Providing access at another nearby gate.
- Developing a traffic safety plan and deploying signage in the area.
- Working with the City of Albuquerque on traffic flow.
- Diverting contractors and suppliers to the KAFB contractor gate, near the Carlisle gate.
- Encouraging employees to ride public transportation and use other commuting alternatives.

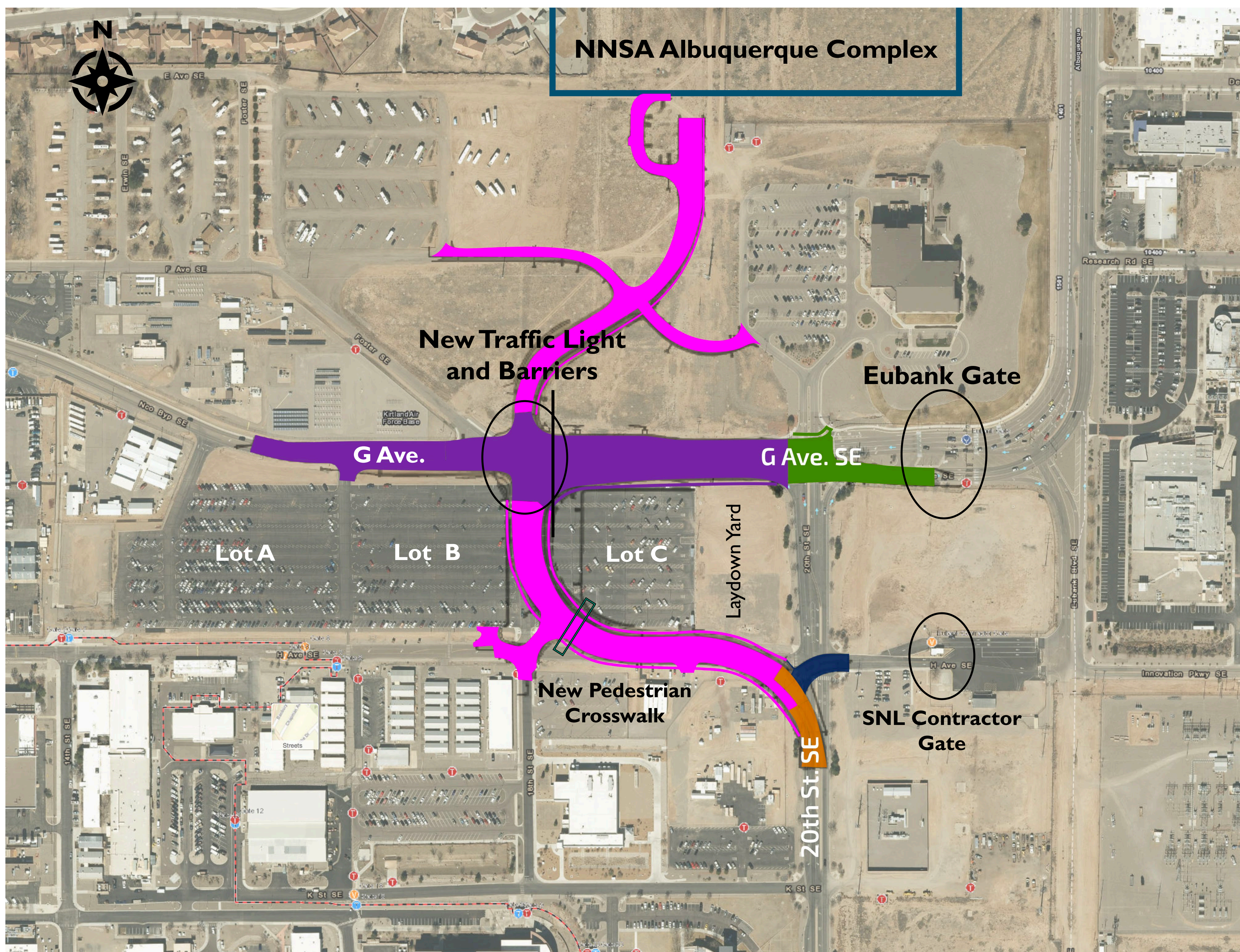
