CALL 911 IF EMERGENCY CARE IS NEEDED

IF not, contact the SARC FIRST!

(when calling Command Post, ask for SARC without giving your name to maintain confidentiality)

*Sharing details about the assault to others may jeopardize reporting options. **Talk to SARC first!***

If you are a friend helping the victim - Care for the Victim's Needs

- *Let the victim speak to the SARC in private*
- *Don't ask questions about the assault*
- *Remind the victim not to eat, drink, shower, use restroom until SARC provides guidance*
- *Stay with the victim until support arrives*

CALL THE SARC for ADVICE!!! Discussing your concerns with your Supervisor, Flight Chief, or First Sgt. will cause an Unrestricted Report – Keep your information confidential – Start with a Restricted Report – **TALK TO THE SARC!!**

Restricted

Active Duty and Dependents of AD 18 and older along with AF DoD Civilians:

You want **CONFIDENTIALITY** so your reporting option will be a **Restricted Report** taken by the SARC!

SARC will **NOT** contact police or Commander

You will receive:

Medical Care

Evidence can be collected

Special Victims Counsel (SVC)

You can choose to go Unrestricted at any time!

Unrestricted

Police investigation will ensue & Commander will be notified by **SARC** in a private and confidential manner.

Your Information will be handled Discreetly by your Commander and First Sgt. – **SARC** will intervene and will be actively involved to help with your needs.

You will receive:

Medical Care

Evidence collected

Special Victims Counsel (SVC)

Your report CANNOT go Restricted
